Proposal for Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan (United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization)

Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan: Reducing Vulnerabilities of Populations in the Central Asia Region from Glacier Lake Outburst Floods in Changing Climate (Fully-developed project; United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO); ASI/MIE/DRR/2015/1; US\$ 6,500,000).

Having considered the recommendation of the Project and Programme Review Committee, the Adaptation Fund Board (the Board) decided to:

- a) Approve the fully-developed project proposal, as supplemented by the clarification responses provided by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO); to the request made by the technical review;
- b) Approve the funding of US\$ 6,500,000 for the implementation of the project, as requested by UNESCO; and
- c) Request the secretariat to draft an agreement with UNESCO as the multilateral implementing entity for the project. The agreement will include a condition that, prior to first disbursement, UNESCO will submit a provisional pipeline of investments to the Adaptation Fund Board secretariat.
