Proposal for Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Niger, Nigeria (WMO)

Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Niger, Nigeria: Integrated Water Resources Management and Early Warning System for Climate Change Resilience in the Lake Chad Basin (Concept note; United Nations World Meteorological Organization (WMO); AF00000224; US\$ 10,620,000)

Having considered the recommendation of the Project and Programme Review Committee, the Adaptation Fund Board (the Board) <u>decided</u> to:

- (a) Endorse the concept note as supplemented by the clarification responses provided by the United Nations World Meteorological Organization (WMO) to the request made by the technical review;
- (b) Request the secretariat to notify WMO of the observations in the review sheet annexed to the notification of the Board's decision, as well as the following issues:
 - (i) The fully developed project proposal should further elaborate on the costeffectiveness of the regional approach as well as provide a quantification of overall benefits of proposed regional activities:
 - (ii) The fully developed project proposal should provide a comprehensive analysis on the project sustainability including operation and maintenance and scalability of the proposed measures;
- (c) Approve the project formulation grant of US\$ 80,000;
- (d) Request WMO to transmit the observations under subparagraph (b) to the Governments of Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Niger, Nigeria;
- (e) Encourage the Governments of Cameroon, Central African Republic, Chad, Niger, Nigeria to submit, through WMO, a fully developed proposal that would also address the observations under subparagraph (b), above.
